ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Opens on Tuesday, May 7, at 9:00 AM. Please enter through **Gate 37** located off of Tunnel Rd. For your convenience, cars in tow that will not fit in your reserved parking area will be parked in the Overnight Parking area.

Your windshield will be marked as you check in at the gate. If you have a tow vehicle it will be marked as well. **Vehicles without the proper permit displayed at all times will be towed at the owner's expense. Due to safety reasons, Darlington Raceway will be strictly enforcing this rule with inspections throughout the weekend.**

Any additional companion vehicles or guest vehicles must park in the Vehicle Parking for overnight parking or a General Daily Parking Lot for single day parking. Overnight parking is available Tuesday – Sunday, ask parking attendant for additional information.

Parking is only allowed in your assigned space. You must park in your assigned area and any personal property, including your one tow/ companion vehicles, MUST fit within your designated space.

CAMPFIRE RULES & REGULATIONS

- Campfires are allowed as long as it is in a fire ring or a contained container. Do not leave it unattended.

OUTDOOR FIREPLACE CHARACTERISTICS

Fires must be in approved outdoor fireplaces constructed of steel, clay, concrete, or other non-combustible materials. Fires may not be built directly on the ground. Outdoor fireplaces may not exceed a diameter of 36" and are limited to a height of 24". Fires must be farther than 15 feet from vehicles, campers, or other combustibles.

PROHIBITIONS

Fire wood shall not be cut or removed from Darlington Raceway property. Sufficient water must also be supplied to extinguish fires as needed.

Fireworks and flying lantern are prohibited. Burning trash or other rubbish is prohibited. Flammable liquids shall not be used to start or contribute to a fire.

Hot coals/embers shall not be discarded on the ground or left unattended. Charcoal must be disposed of properly. Each site must be free of debris, including ash and fire wood, upon departure from the lot. Any unattended fire will be extinguished and the right to have a fire will be revoked for that camper. RV Parking lots will be inspected several times during the day and night for compliance of the rules and regulations.

Darlington Raceway and/or Darlington Fire reserves the authority to suspend outdoor fires due to unsafe weather or for any other safety considerations that may arise.

LOT REGULATIONS

If you plan to park on Darlington Raceway property, you must obey the following regulations:

1. Each space measures approximately 20'x40', XL spaces are 25'x50'. Tents are not allowed.
2. Quiet hours are from Midnight to 6:00 AM daily. During this time, loud music, large gatherings, and unruly behavior will not be tolerated. Any vehicle causing a disturbance to neighboring sites may be relocated or removed from the property. To report any incidents please contact race track security at 843-395-8849.
3. Please be considerate of your neighbors. Responsible behavior, including consumption of alcohol, and respectful language is required.
4. Do not park in other sites or block access to other sites, roadways, fire lanes or dump stations.
5. Weapons of any type are strictly prohibited and will be confiscated. Those items include, but are not limited to, firearms, sporting knives, spotlights, laser pointers or other items deemed dangerous by Darlington Raceway. Possession may result in your removal from Darlington Raceway property.
6. **Tent camping is not permitted in this RV parking lot. It is only permitted in the Tent Camping Campground.**
7. Tailgating/canopy tents must be staked at all times. Failure to stake properly will result in removal of the tent. Car ports and other large structures are prohibited on property during race weekend.
8. Please place all trash and recyclables in plastic bags, tie them, and place them in the trash or recycle cans provided throughout the parking lot.
9. All pets must be kept on a leash. You must clean up after your pets.
10. Unauthorized golf carts, motor scooters, and any other motorized cycles are not permitted on Darlington Raceway property. Guests with special needs can receive assistance from Guest Services. Licensed motorcycles are allowed on Raceway property. However, they are not to be used for transportation around the facility.
11. Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) and drones are strictly prohibited on Darlington Raceway property. Anyone using a UAV on Darlington Raceway property is subject to removal and the confiscation of the UAV.
12. Banners, flags, or poles must not be displayed higher than 15 feet off the ground. Only non-metallic flagpoles are permitted (fiberglass, PVC, vinyl). Steel, aluminum, other metal flagpoles are not permitted. The display of the Confederate flag is prohibited from all NASCAR events and properties. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.
13. The use of generators are permitted. We ask for generators to remain quiet, if not, we will ask for them to be turned off. All exhaust MUST be directed up and away from each vehicle. Use caution when operating generators, charcoal or gas stoves, heaters and lights.
14. No corporate branded vehicles or wrapped RV's will be allowed in the RV parking lot. Sampling and/or the distribution of premium items to event attendees from your camp site or from any area at the Raceway is strictly prohibited at all times. No solicitation and/or data collection activities are permitted on the premises at any time.

VIOLATION OF THESE REGULATIONS, MAJOR DISTURBANCES, OR UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES IN THE PARKING AREA CAN RESULT IN THE LOSS OF SITE AND PARKING PRIVILEGES.

Darlington Raceway is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please make sure you secure any personal belongings throughout your stay. Darlington Raceway strives to operate a safe facility. These regulations are designed to allow us all to meet this goal.
